Action Day Briefing - High Street

OVERVIEW

Putney High Street is at a tipping point.

- There are over 20 empty shops on the High Street.
- While the return of Marks & Spencer has lifted local spirits, it also reminds us just how far the High Street has fallen.
- Footfall is high, but the mix of shops is poor. A recent survey of 500+ locals showed frustration about the lack of clothing stores, independents, and food options.

WHAT WE'RE DOING TODAY

This activity is about **showing up**, **starting conversations**, and giving residents a **voice**.

We've picked **five key empty shops** along Putney High Street. See leaflet and map. On each, you'll find/provide:

- A large poster asking: "What should go here?"
- A set of coloured stickers people can place to say what they'd like to see (e.g. Independent Retail / Other / Clothing / Food)

We're asking passers-by to:

- ✓ Place a sticker on each poster
- Scan the **QR code** to give more detailed feedback
- ✓ Leave their email if they want to receive the results

YOUR ROLE

- · Be welcoming and visible!
- Encourage people to take part and explain the activity in one sentence:

"We're asking locals what they want to see on the High Street – just pop a sticker on the shop and tell us what you'd love to have here!"

- Offer to help them scan the QR code on their phone
- Ask if they'd like to leave an email to stay informed

📌 WHY IT MATTERS

One of the keys to revitalising our High Street is **community-led engagement**. We're giving people an easy, visible way to participate – and showing that local Lib Dems are listening, acting, and full of ideas.
